Technical	Please note this was an error on our part. The timeframes listed under Page 21 in the deliverables apply in this instate i.e. eight (8) months.
2	With regards to the Qualifications & Skills of the Proposed Project Team Members, is this a mandatory requirement? In other words an inviolate condition. The reason for the clarification required is that the team members have other academic qualifications relating to agriculture and animal sciences, amongst others.	Technical	This is not a mandatory requirement. Bidders will be scored on this criteria. Meaning that bidders who fully meet the requirement will be scored as such. Those that do not will be scored less, with the risk of not achieving the minimum qualifying score of 70% as stated under point 13.2.1 on Page 13 of the tender document.
3	Would the IDC object to multiple emails truncating the flow of information, identified with referencing "Page One of Ten pages" and so on and so forth in order to stay within the 50MB size cap? In other words a series of separate emails (back-to-back) with the various completed attachments which make up the entire Bid packet (of completed documents).
